The Director General of the Forest Department, under the Ministry of Natural Resources and Environmental Conservation, in accordance with Section 22, Subsection (a) of the Law on the Conservation of Biodiversity and Protected Areas, hereby designates and announces the following wild animal species, which are protected due to their risk of extinction, as species that may be commercially bred.
